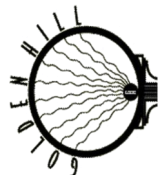
CLEAN, GREEN, SAFE

HISTORY OF THE GOLDEN HILL CDC

The Greater Golden Hill CDC was formed in 1991 as a non-profit 501(c)3 organization by a group of neighborhood residents, who resolved to reverse the tide of crime and deterioration that had overcome their community. Local leaders created a groundswell of support among their neighbors for safer, graffiti-free streets, unbroken sidewalks, improved lighting, and new landscaping—support which convinced the City and private funders to dedicate more than \$3.5 million to these causes.

Those revitalization efforts were overseen by the GGHCDC, and their success sparked a broader vision of affordable housing, economic revitalization and youth development which continues to this day.
